the fifth elephant is the latest installment in the discworld cycle starring dwarfs diplomacy intrigue and big lumps of fat sam vimes is a man on the run yesterday he was a duke a chief of police and the ambassador to the mysterious fat rich country of uberwald now he has nothing but his native wit and the gloomy trousers of uncle vanya don t ask it s snowing it s freezing and if he can t make it through the forest to civilization there s going to be a terrible war but there are monsters on his trail they are bright they are fast and they are catching up

well he thought so this is diplomacy it s lying only for a better class of people commander sam vimes of the ankh morpork city watch is a long way from home sent as reluctant ambassador to uberwald a mysterious region inhabited by dwarfs vampires and werewolves vimes must learn the art of diplomacy fast but when he uncovers a mystery with ties back home the policeman in him can t help but investigate what could possibly go wrong well quite a lot actually vimes finds himself on the run through the frozen forests of uberwald armed with only his wits and the trousers of uncle vanya don t ask and if he doesn t make it there s going to be a terrible war but there are monsters on his trail they re smart they re fast they re werewolves and they re catching up precisely balanced a cracking comic thriller the times the fifth elephant is the fifth book in the city watch series but you can read the discworld novels in any order

pratchett cheerfully takes readers on an exuberant tale of mystery and invention along the way he skewers everything from monarchy to fascism as well as communism and capitalism oil wealth and ethnic identities russian plays immigration condoms and

evangelical christianity in short everything worth talking about publishers weekly elephants werewolves and ruby tights oh my collide in this clever discworld tale rich in mystery myth intrigue and a dollop of diplomacy from the legendary new york times bestselling author terry pratchett everyone knows that the world is flat and supported on the backs of four elephants but weren't there supposed to be five indeed there were so where is the fifth elephant commander sam vimes of the ankh morpork constabulary is the man to find out a copper through and through he's been invited to attend a royal function as a diplomat ambassador to the mysterious fat rich country of uberwald complete with ruby tights of course where cops go crime follows an attempted assassination and a theft soon lead to a desperate chase from the low halls of discworld royalty to the legendary fat mines of uberwald where lard is found in underground seams along with tusks and teeth and other precious ivory artifacts it's up to the dauntless vimes to solve the puzzle of the missing pachyderm after all that's what he does only there are monsters on his trail bright fast toothy werewolves and they're catching up the discworld novels can be read in any order but the fifth elephant is the 5th book in the city watch collection the city watch series in order guards guards men at arms feet of clay jingo the fifth elephant night watch thud snuff

commander vimes is sent to wild wintry uberwald to establish trade links with the king of the dwarfs but he ends up trying to stop an inter species war while being chased by a pack of fascist werewolves who don't play by the rules

throughout history from at least as far back as the epic of gilgamesh mankind has shown a fascination with physical transformation especially that of humans into animals tales of such transformations appear in every culture across the course of history they have been featured in the western world in the work of such authors as ovid petronius marie de france saint augustine jack williamson charles de lint charaline harris terry pratchett and j k rowling this book approaches werewolves as representations of a proposed shape shifter archetype examining with reference to earlier sources how and why the archetype has been employed in modern literature although the archetype is in a state of flux by its very definition many common threads are linked throughout the literary landscape even as modern authors add modify and reinvent characteristics and meanings this is especially true in the work of such authors examined in this book many of whom have struck a chord with a wide range of readers and non readers around the world they seem to have tapped into something that affects their audiences on a subconscious level

a new stage adaptation of one of pratchett's best selling novels commander vimes is sent to wild wintry and transylvania like uberwald to establish trade links with the king of the dwarfs but he ends up trying to stop an inter species war on his side though is a talking dog a reformed vampyre and a self made man you can tell he's self made because the stitches still show vimes may have arrived as ankh morpork's ambassador but he soon finds it's not all golden chocolate balls now he's an escaped prisoner out in the icy woods wearing only the gloomy trousers of uncle vanya and being chased by a pack of fascist werewolves who don't play by the rules one of the funniest authors alive the independent
